

 - The future of the MOU or other contractual agreements with the US DOC





= 18 Months of Necessary Space	Available Space: < 50% of 1 Allocation Unit	/12 Regardless of Utilization or Transferred Space	IANA, NRO, RIRs will: • Make Announcements • Update Websites
Unit Size: /12*	<u>OR</u> Available Space is < 9 Month Necessary Space		
	<u>OR</u> Special Need Exists		

***Upon policy inception, each RIR receives a /12 if it has < /12 on hand.**



Need	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Current policy promulgated by IETF in 1999• Precedes global PDP
Discuss	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Discussed all regions on mailing lists• Discussed in 4 of 5 Regional Fora
Consensus	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Reached in all RIRs where discussed in policy meetings
Implement	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Impact Analysis• Liability Analysis
Evaluate	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Enabled by Statistical Collection
