ICANN ASO/AC (Address Council)

- **Who is it?**
 - NRO NC (Number Council) elected members + NIR appointees
- **How is it Organized**
 - 15 members (3 from each of the 5 regions)
 - In each region: 2 elected the community. 1 appointed by RIR board
- **What does it do?**
 - Oversees Internet Resources global policy development
 - Advice ICANN board members
 - Select 2 of the ICANN board members (seat 9 and 10)

 - Conference calls in January, February, April and May.



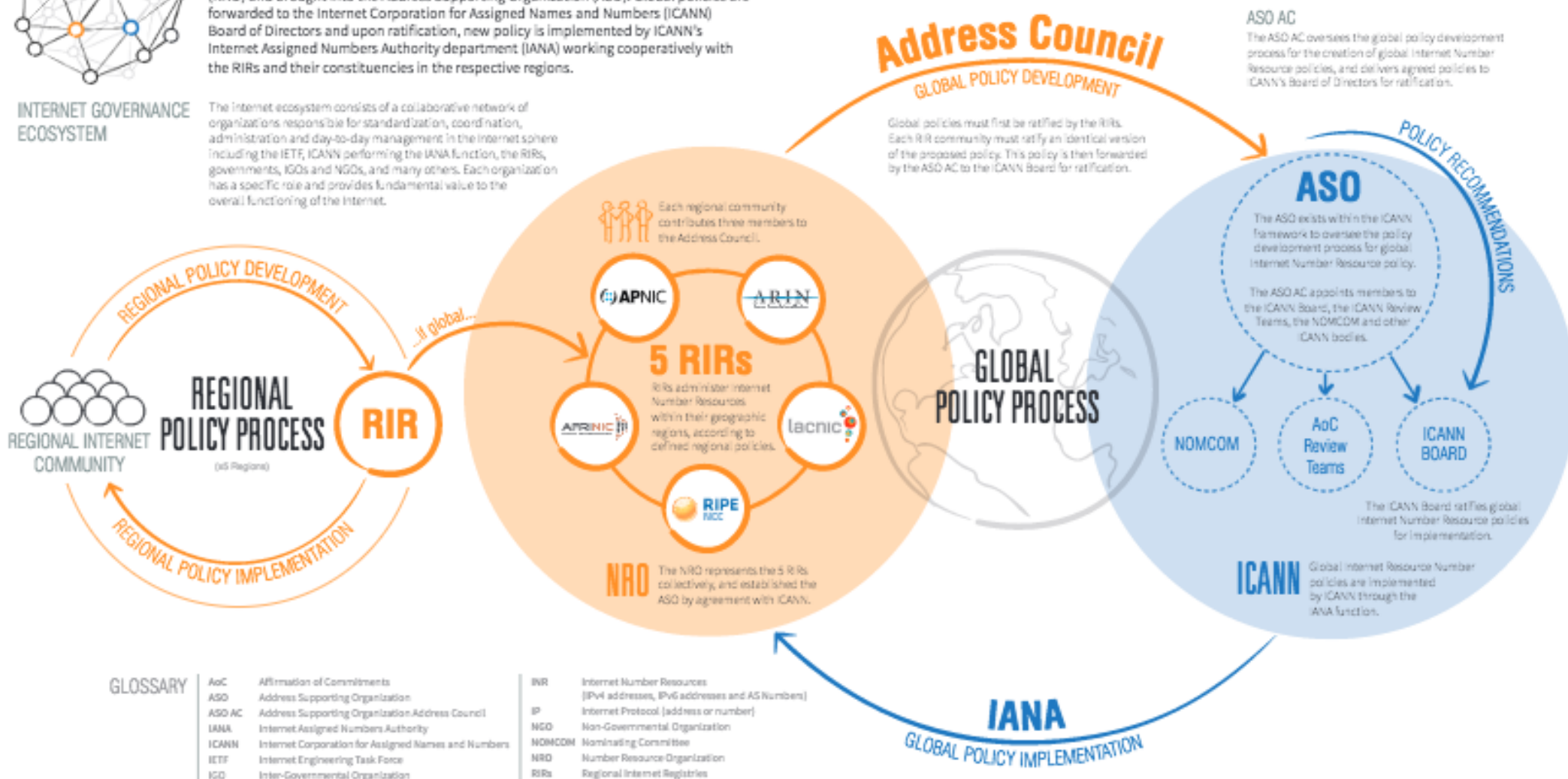
INTERNET NUMBER RESOURCE POLICY LIFE CYCLE



INTERNET GOVERNANCE ECOSYSTEM

Global Internet Number Resource policy is developed through a bottom-up, open, and inclusive approach. Beginning in geographic regions, issues are raised through the Regional Internet Registry (RIR) communities in the Number Resource Organization (NRO) and brought into the Address Supporting Organization (ASO). Global policies are forwarded to the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers (ICANN) Board of Directors and upon ratification, new policy is implemented by ICANN's Internet Assigned Numbers Authority department (IANA) working cooperatively with the RIRs and their constituencies in the respective regions.

The Internet ecosystem consists of a collaborative network of organizations responsible for standardization, coordination, administration and day-to-day management in the Internet sphere including the IETF, ICANN performing the IANA function, the RIRs, governments, IGOs and NGOs, and many others. Each organization has a specific role and provides fundamental value to the overall functioning of the Internet.



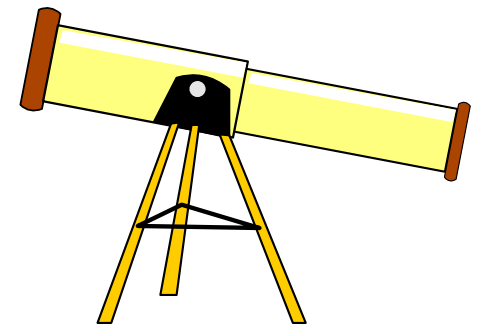

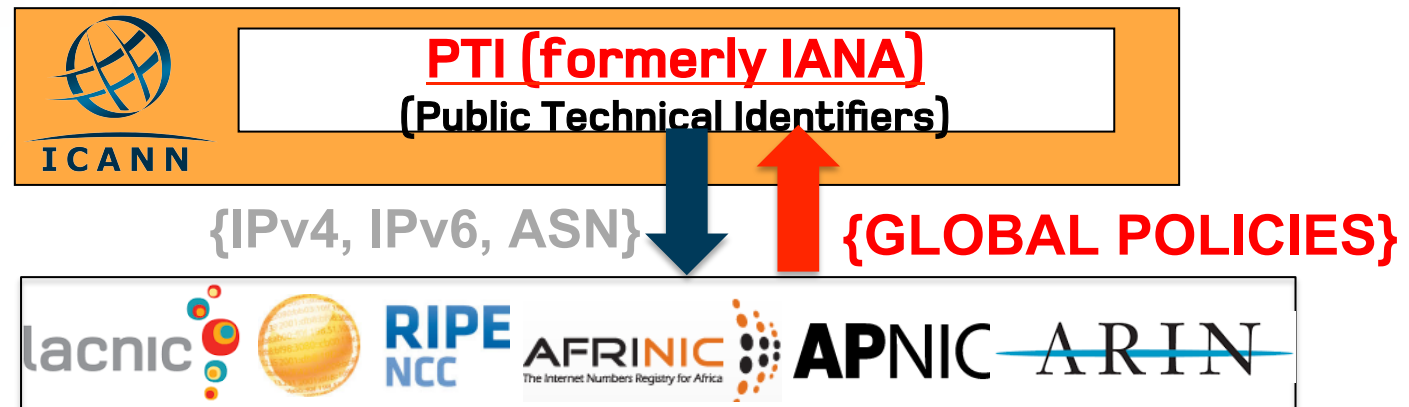
ASO AC Activities: Global Policies

- *ASO/AC does not develop policies*
- Internet Number Resources Policies developed inside each RIR according to its own procedures
 - Participation open and transparent / Bottom-up process
- Main topics motivating policy proposals within the RIR communities
 - IPv4 Transfers (LACNIC, RIPE NCC, ARIN, APNIC, AFRINIC)
 - IPv6 (RIPE NCC, LACNIC)
 - IPv4 Address Recovery (LACNIC)



ASO AC Activities: Global Policies

- Global policies relates to the one applied to PTI (formerly IANA) in the services to RIR
 - Same text discussed and approved in the 5 RIR regions
 - Reviewed by ASO
 - Ratified by ICANN
